- Farm Teens is for rising 7th graders- rising 12th graders- if your child was in middle school or highschool for the 24/25 school year.

Daily Activities/Lesson Topics Could Include *(but are subject to change):*

Dairy Farming:

- Pasture walks with our farmers, cow-milking, exploring milk-based products (cheese, butter, ice cream,) making

Vegetable/Plant Farming:

- Caring for plants, harvesting plants, creating snacks with vegetables, exploring flower gardens and creating bouquets

Animal Interactions:

- Meet our Jersey cows, milk a cow, pet/feed baby calf, care for bunnies, connect with pigs and more!

- Children will participate in a tour of our ice cream factory, make their own flavor of ice cream, participate in water play/ messy games and then finish with a farmer's market run by the campers themselves!
